# **CDFI** Resource Gap

## Recent Legislation

Congress stepped up to meet this challenge through new bipartisan programs

Emergency Capital Investment Program

Rapid Response and Equitable Recovery Program

\$9 billion in capital for long-term preferred stock and subordinated debt investments in depository CDFIs and MDIs.

\$1.25 billion (RRP) in grants made to 863 CDFIs to respond to the pandemic, and \$1.75 billion (ERP) in grants and technical assistance to expand CDFI activities



# Challenges to Scale

# **Building on Recent Momentum**

Coordination and expansion of private sector and government efforts would build on recent momentum

#### **Caucus Priorities**

**Education:** Organize and host events focused on targeted challenges facing community-based lenders to educate Members and staff.

**Coordination:** Coordinate bipartisan efforts – regulatory or legislative – related to CDFIs and provide a venue for staff-to-staff information sharing.

**Legislation:** Develop legislative efforts to further support CDFIs and MDIs.

**Tracking:** Track the implementation of federal programs and private sector commitments.



**Additional Tier 1 capital investments** to build on programs like ECIP



**Direct lending to mission-aligned** institutions to expand their activities



Liquidity and secondary market support for loans to underserved communities (from CDFIs, MDIs, community banks)



Technical assistance to make lasting investments in key capabilities
