2 fiscal during any period during which there is an ongoing  
3 violation of the Congressional Budget and Impoundment  
4 Control Act of 1974, as determined by the Comptroller

6 (b) WAIVER AND APPEAL.—Subsection (a) may be  
7 waived or suspended in the Senate only by an affirmative  
8 vote of three-fifths of the Members, duly chosen and  
9 sworn. An affirmative vote of three-fifths of the Members  
10 of the Senate, duly chosen and sworn, shall be required  
11 to sustain an appeal of the ruling of the Chair on a point  
12 of order raised under subsection (a).
