7 (a) Point of Order.—It shall not be in order in			
8 the Senate to consider a reconciliation bill or a reconcili-			
9 ation resolution pursuant to section 310 of the Congres-			
10 sional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 (2			

- 1 U.S.C. 644), or an amendment to, conference report on,
- 2 or amendment between the Houses in relation to such a
- 3 bill or resolution, that rescinds amounts made available
- 4 under Public Law 117-169 (136 Stat. 1818), commonly
- 5 known as the "Inflation Reduction Act of 2022", that
- 6 have been obligated or awarded.
- 7 (b) WAIVER AND APPEAL.—Subsection (a) may be
- 8 waived or suspended in the Senate only by an affirmative
- 9 vote of three-fifths of the Members, duly chosen and
- 10 sworn. An affirmative vote of three-fifths of the Members
- 11 of the Senate, duly chosen and sworn, shall be required
- 12 to sustain an appeal of the ruling of the Chair on a point
- 13 of order raised under subsection (a).
