- 2 **SEC. 4 ____ . POINT OF ORDER AGAINST RECONCILIATION**
- 3 **LEGISLATION IF CERTAIN FEDERAL CIVIL**
- 4 **SERVICE LAWS ARE BEING VIOLATED.**
- 5 (a) POINT OF ORDER.—It shall not be in order in
- 6 the Senate to consider a reconciliation bill or a reconcili-
- 7 ation resolution pursuant to section 310 of the Congres-
- 8 sional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 (2
- 9 U.S.C. 644), or an amendment to, conference report on,
- 10 or amendment between the Houses in relation to such a

1 bill or resolution, if there is an ongoing violation of section
2 1341 of title 31, United States Code, as determined by
3 the Comptroller General, or if there are any employees
4 being paid in violation of section 3103 of title 5, United
5 States Code, which requires civil service employees to be
6 paid "only for services actually rendered in connection
7 with and for the purposes of the appropriation for which"
8 the employee is paid.

9 (b) WAIVER AND APPEAL.—Subsection (a) may be
10 waived or suspended in the Senate only by an affirmative
11 vote of three-fifths of the Members, duly chosen and
12 sworn. An affirmative vote of three-fifths of the Members
13 of the Senate, duly chosen and sworn, shall be required
14 to sustain an appeal of the ruling of the Chair on a point
15 of order raised under subsection (a).
