1 **SEC. 4 ____.** **POINT OF ORDER AGAINST CONSIDERATION**
2 **OF RECONCILIATION LEGISLATION UNTIL**
3 **THE CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET OFFICE CER-**
4 **TIFIES THAT HEALTH, EDUCATION, RE-**

7 **NOT SUBJECT TO PROGRAMMATIC FUNDING**

9 (a) POINT OF ORDER.—On and after the first day
10 of a fiscal year, it shall not be in order in the Senate to
11 consider a reconciliation bill or a reconciliation resolution
12 pursuant to section 310 of the Congressional Budget and
13 Impoundment Control Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 644), or an
14 amendment to, conference report on, or amendment be-
15 tween the Houses in relation to such a bill or resolution,
16 unless the Director of the Congressional Budget Office has
17 submitted to Congress a certification indicating that
18 amounts appropriated for health, education, research, law
19 enforcement, and foreign aid for such fiscal year are not
20 being subject to programmatic funding delays, deferrals,
21 or rescissions.

22 (b) WAIVER AND APPEAL.—Subsection (a) may be
23 waived or suspended in the Senate only by an affirmative
24 vote of three-fifths of the Members, duly chosen and
25 sworn. An affirmative vote of three-fifths of the Members
26 of the Senate, duly chosen and sworn, shall be required

- 1 to sustain an appeal of the ruling of the Chair on a point
- 2 of order raised under subsection (a).
